

Take a look outside! Have you noticed the increased bird activity?

The male Northern Cardinal is easy to spot because he is bright red and his call sounds like a sci-fi laser beam going "Pew-Pew!" See if you can find one in your neighborhood! Record it in your science journal. The female Cardinal looks similar but is grey and light orange.
