Take a look outside! Have you noticed the increased bird activity?

The male Northern Cardinal is easy to spot because he is bright red and his call sounds like a sci-fi laser beam going “Pew-Pew!” See if you can find one in your neighborhood! Record it in your science journal. The female Cardinal looks similar but is grey and light orange.



**Monday, April 13<sup>th</sup>**

Way before cell phones and even film cameras, early scientists had to draw everything they observed as a way to record observations.

Try your hand at drawing something from the natural world in a realistic, detailed, “still life” 2D drawing. Start with something simple like a leaf, a rock, an insect, or flower.
